

Richard A. Warshak, Ph.D. is a graduate of Cornell University and a past Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center who consults and testifies internationally in child custody proceedings. His studies appear in 14 books and more than 75 articles on the psychology of alienated children; children's involvement in custody disputes; and outcomes of divorce, child custody decisions, stepfamilies, and relocations. His consensus report on parenting plans for young children was endorsed by 110 social scientists and published in an American Psychological Association journal.

Dr. Warshak consulted to the White House on child custody and is a member of the multi-partisan commission to create a White House Council on Boys and Men. Dr. Warshak's amicus brief on relocation and alienation, endorsed by leading authorities on divorce, is widely regarded as having influenced a landmark decision of the California Supreme Court, and the Supreme Court of New Jersey cited his work in a 2017 landmark decision on relocation.

Dr. Warshak appears in the PBS documentary *Kids And Divorce*, and his book, **DIVORCE POISON: HOW TO PROTECT YOUR FAMILY FROM BAD-MOUTHING AND BRAINWASHING**, is widely regarded as a classic and is the best selling book for divorced parents.
